LINDENFELSER APPOINTED SECOND VICE CHAIR OF MREA BOARD

A member of the board and representative of District 4 since 2013, Lindenfelser is eligible to run as representative again in 2016 for another three-year term.

There are 44 distribution cooperatives and six generation and transmission members of MREA.

WH is a member-owned non-profit electric utility that provides electric power to Wright County and the western part of Hennepin County. The cooperative has been a corporate citizen in this area since 1937 and currently serves more than 46,000 electric accounts. The utility started its security division in 1989 and provides local home security solutions as well as monitors alarm systems for almost 60,000 customers in 32 states and three Canadian provinces.
