WRIGHT-HENNEPIN MEMBERS DONATE \$37,650 TO LOCAL ORGANIZATIONS

Rockford, Minn. (December 29, 2023) — Wright-Hennepin Cooperative Electric Association (WH) members who participate in Operation Round Up (ORU) donated grants totaling \$37,650 in December. ORU has awarded more than \$5.1 million since it began in 1994.

ORU participants allow their electric bills to be rounded up to the nearest dollar. The rounded amount is then used for donations supporting local programs. Approximately 90% of WH's members participate in the ORU program, contributing a total of almost \$20,000 each month. ORU's board manages the donated money, which is held in a trust fund. Through a selection process and review of guidelines, the ORU trustees evaluate funding requests on a bimonthly basis.

The ORU trust board donated the following on behalf of WH members at their December meeting:

- **\$7,500, Children's Home Society of MN,** funds to support education and adoption services and family support.
- \$7,500, Haven Homes, funds to jumpstart and support bus purchase program.
- **\$5,000, Boys and Girls Club,** funds to support programming and meals for youth at Voyageur Environmental Center.
- **\$5,000, Toys for Tots Buffalo,** funds to support purchase of toys for needy families, especially for teenagers.
- **\$5,000, YMCA Camp Ihduhapi**, funds to support scholarship for day and overnight camp programs.
- \$3,900, Otsego Lions Gifts Anonymous, funds to support families in need over Christmas.
- \$3,000, Angel Bears of Love, funds to support the gift of an Angel Bear to children and adults with life-threatening diseases.
- \$750, MN Pioneer Park, funds to support new window for museum.
