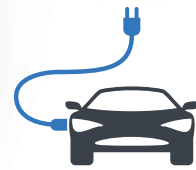


# WH electric vehicle (EV) Level 2 charging station options



## Learn more about Level 2 EV charging station options.

If you are bringing home a new EV, you'll need a charging station for it! WH recommends consulting with a licensed electrician prior to installing your new Level 2 hardwired, 240-volt, wall-mounted charging station.

### Option 1: ZEF Energy Level 2 charging station



WH Energy-Saving Program (ESP) and Conservation Improvement Program (CIP) rebates of up to \$1,000 are available. WH has partnered with Energy Wise MN to take the guesswork out of purchasing an EV charging station.

No additional metering equipment is required with a ZEF Energy charging station; the metering equipment is onboard the charging station.

The EV must be a battery electric vehicle (BEV), and have a minimum of 4.5kW charger rating in order to qualify.

### Option 2: Bring your own charging station

Conservation Improvement Program (CIP) rebates of up to \$500 are available. If you choose a charging station brand other than ZEF Energy, you can choose to participate in any of WH's ESP EV charging programs. An additional, separate meter will need to be installed to participate.

Please note that once you have chosen a charging program, you may not be able to switch to a different program, as different metering equipment is required for each program.

The EV must be a battery electric vehicle (BEV), and have a minimum of 4.5kW charger rating in order to qualify.



### ADDITIONAL REBATE INFORMATION:

Enrollment in an electric vehicle charging program is required to receive a rebate.

Rebates are only available on new installations.

Energy-Saving Program (ESP) rebates are available with the purchase of a ZEF Energy charging station and given as an instant credit when the charging station is purchased through the Energy Wise MN Store website.

Conservation Improvement Program (CIP) rebates are applied as a bill credit on the member's WH electric account after ESP installation is completed.

Rebates are paid on a first-come, first-served basis. Terms and conditions are subject to change. Plug-in hybrid electric vehicles (PHEVs) do not qualify for rebates.

State electrical inspection must be completed within 30 days of the equipment's installation.

Please allow six to eight weeks for rebate processing after installation.
