- 3. Any time power is off & restored to the radio receiver, there will be a 15 minute time delay before unit will be allowed to operate.
- 4. Load control switch/meter socket must be mounted 4' to 6' above the ground outside of all structures with ample access around unit.
- 5. Mount load control switch above or next to meter socket.
