WRIGHT-HENNEPIN MEMBERS DONATE MORE THAN \$59,000 TO LOCAL ORGANIZATIONS

Rockford, MN (November 5, 2018) — Wright-Hennepin Cooperative Electric Association (WH) members who participate in Operation Round Up (ORU) donated grants totaling \$59,200 in October of 2018.

ORU participants allow their electric bills to be rounded up to the nearest dollar. The rounded amount is then used for donations to fund local programs. More than 80 percent of WH's members participate in the ORU program. ORU's board manages the generated money, which is held in a trust fund. Through a selection process and review of guidelines, the board evaluates funding requests on a bimonthly basis.

The ORU trust board awarded the following donations on behalf of WH members in October 2018:

- \$750, Ambassador Company, funds to support "My Favorite Book" distribution to local school and church programs.
- \$5,000, Annandale Youth First Inc., funds to provide student-to-student mentorship programs.
- \$4,000, Buffalo Area Timber Bay/Youth Investment Foundation, funds to replace a vehicle for the youth they serve with transportation needs to activities, camps and mentoring programs.
- \$5,000, Community Toys for Tots of Monticello, funds to purchase toys and gifts for children 0-17 years of age.
- \$7,500, MN Adult and Teen Challenge, funds to support the "Know the Truth" drug prevention program.
- \$5,000, Toys for Tots of Buffalo, funds to purchase toys and gifts for children 0-17 years of age.


