Terms of WH Rebate Program

- Metered water storage rebate amount is up to \$200 for one 100-gallon water heater and mixing valve.
- Rebates will be issued as a credit on your Wright-Hennepin (WH) account.
- Water heater must be installed within WH service territory.
- Water heater will be on the Metered Water Storage Energy-Saving Program (ESP).
- Recharge times:
 - From October 1 – April 30: Recharge between 10 p.m. – 6 a.m., Monday – Friday.
 - From May 1 – September 30: Recharge between 10 p.m. – 9 a.m., Monday – Friday.
 - Weekends and holidays: No control except for peak conditions, high energy prices or system emergencies.
- Energy will be sold at the current off-peak rate. The energy sold for this program will not be subject to the Power Cost Adjustment.
- Water heater must be sized appropriately for the family and square footage of the home.
- Member is responsible for water heater installation cost and maintenance of the water heater.
- HTP carries a limited lifetime warranty. Register your water heater at <https://htp.my.site.com/s/>
- Manufacturer installation requirements must be followed to ensure you do not void warranty.
- Hot Water Recirculation units (gravity or pumped) are not recommended to be used with the water heating programs.

Terms, continued

- Smart tanks or tanks equipped with wifi capabilities are not eligible to participate in the Program.
- Member will pay the cost and arrange installation for all special equipment and/or additional switching mechanism necessary.
- The ESP meter and receiver equipment will need to be located outside the home.
- Contact Wright-Hennepin (WH) at (763) 477-3000 for final ESP inspection. ESP rates and rebates will not be applied until final inspection is completed.
- Fill out this form completely. **Form must be signed by the WH member applying for the rebate.** Incomplete forms will be returned.
- Please allow six to eight weeks for rebate processing after ESP installation and inspection.
- The ESP for the water heater will be required to be in place for a minimum of five years. If removed, the rebate will be prorated and billed to your electric account.
- By applying for the rebate, you are agreeing to the terms of the program.
- Must be purchased between January 1 - December 31, 2026. Submit the completed rebate form and a copy of the original sales receipt within 90 days of purchase to:

Rebates are available only for members participating in the Residential Metered Water Storage Program. Rebate dollars are limited and will be paid on a first-come, first-served basis. The water heater must be installed where electricity is supplied by WH. Rebate submittal must follow the guidelines as outlined by WH. WH is not responsible for inaccurate information supplied by vendors. The rate/credit and rebate offered by this program are subject to change without notice. By participating in this program, participants acknowledge that the pricing and rebate amounts are not fixed and may be adjusted in the future. Participants accept any such changes to the program.
