WRIGHT-HENNEPIN HOSTS MEMBER LUNCH, FALL FESTIVAL TO CELEBRATE NATIONAL CO-OP MONTH

Rockford, Minn. (November 1, 2022) — To celebrate National Co-op Month in October, Wright-Hennepin Cooperative Electric Association (WH) hosted its annual Member Lunch on Tuesday, October 11, and annual Fall Festival on Thursday, October 27.

The Member Lunch had a final attendance of just over 250 members, who were invited to enjoy a hot dog or bratwurst, potato salad, chips, and a cookie at the cooperative's Rockford headquarters.
