

WRIGHT-HENNEPIN GENERAL SERVICE TIME-OF-USE RATE

I. *Availability*

A. Residential and Single-Phase Agricultural

1. Available to agricultural members with single-phase electrical service and all residential members.
2. The rate applies on a per dwelling basis for both single and multi-dwelling residences.

B. Multi-Phase

1. Available to any member qualifying for Multi-Phase Rate-13.
2. Not available to any members qualifying for Commercial and Industrial (CI) Rate-60.

C. Electric Vehicle

1. Any standalone service dedicated to Electric Vehicle (EV) charging must be on this Time-of-Use Rate unless that service qualifies for CI Rate-60.
 - a. Rate applies to both single and multi-phase services located at residential, multi-family, commercial and industrial.
 - b. Requirement participation is for dedicated services only.
 - c. Dedicated EV services will incur a basic charge.
2. Any EVs that are sub-metered must be on Electric Vehicle Rider-T.

II. *Type of Service*

- A. Single-phase or multi-phase, 60 hertz, at available secondary voltages, through a single meter.

III. Monthly Rate

A. Basic Charge

1. Single-Phase: \$22.40 per month for transformers less than or equal to 50 kVa
2. Multi-Phase: \$39.90 per month for transformers less than or equal to 50 kVa
3. Single-and Multi-Phase: \$62.00 per month for transformers greater than 50 kVa

B. Energy Charge

1. 5:00 PM to 10:00 PM @ \$0.31770 per kWh
2. 5:00 AM to 5:00 PM @ \$0.14470 per kWh
3. 10:00 PM to 5:00 AM @ \$0.07750 per kWh

IV. Power Cost Adjustment

All energy sold under this rate will not be subject to the Power Cost Adjustment (PCA) Rider.

V. Minimum Monthly Bill for EV

The minimum monthly bill shall be the Basic Charge. For members requiring additional capacity, the minimum will be increased by \$0.75 for each additional kVa or, as calculated by the Cooperative to recover the cost of investment in facilities necessary to provide the required capacity, whichever is greater.

VI. Minimum Connection Period

A. The account will remain connected under this TOU rate for a minimum of one year or until the account is transferred. If an account has been disconnected for a period of less than one year and the account is to be reconnected, the member shall pay the minimum bill for the months the service was disconnected, plus the applicable service charge. If an account is disconnected more than six months, an electrical inspection is required, at member's expense, prior to reconnection.
